

IRA FAQs

Why do I need an IRA if I have a pension?

Your pension, while a valuable union benefit, will not replace all your working years' income. It will be up to you to fill in the gap.

You have chosen a physically demanding career. You deserve a dignified and comfortable retirement. A well-funded IRA allows you to decide when you are ready to retire, and to do so with confidence.



Am I allowed to combine my old accounts into this one?

Yes! You can roll assets from other IRAs, or from your former employer's retirement plan, into your BAC Local 1 *IRA Select*. Rollovers do not count toward your annual IRA contribution limit, and there is no fee!

Can my family members participate in this benefit?

Yes. Certain family members are allowed to take advantage of this program including spouses, children, and parents of union members.

How much can I save in my BAC Local 1 IRA Select?

You can contribute up to \$6,000 for 2021, or 100% of your compensation, whichever is less. If you are age 50 or older, you can save an additional \$1,000 each year as a catch-up contribution. Your Traditional and Roth IRA contributions are combined when calculating your annual limits.¹

How much should I contribute to my new account?

How much you need to contribute is a personal decision that varies by lifestyle, goals, and personal situation. A general guideline has long been 10% of a worker's income.
