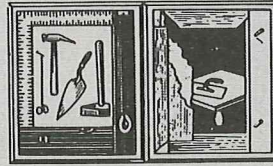

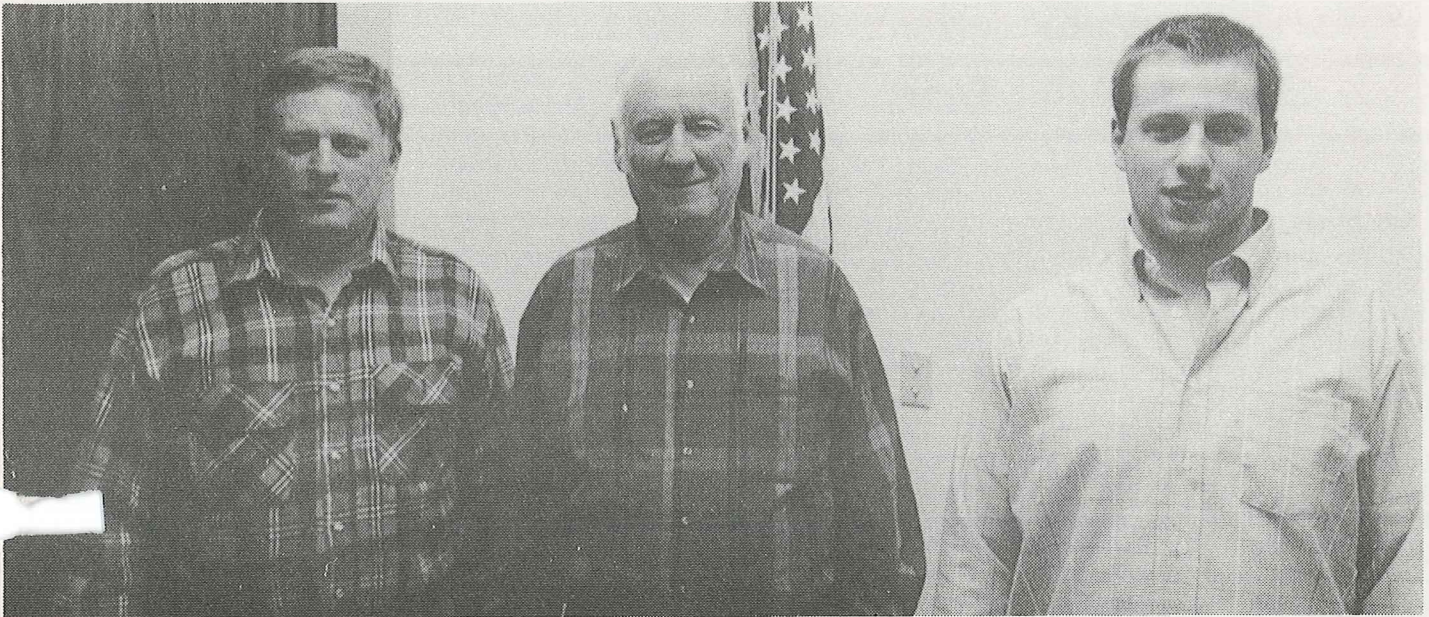

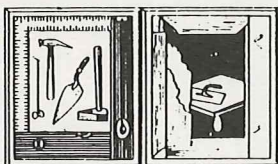

Gordon Nylin Dies

Services were held in January for retired Bricklayers Local 2 Business Manager and Secretary-Treasurer, Gordy Nylin. Nylin was first elected an officer of Local 2 in 1961 and served as Business Manager for the Local until 1990. He was a delegate to the Minnesota Building and Construction Council and a Vice President of the Minnesota AFL-CIO where he served as the Chair of the Constitution and Law Committee. In 1988 Nylin was appointed as Regional Vice President of the International Bricklayers Region 7 office.

A statement by the Local Union reads: "Mr. Nylin was known to his friends and union brothers and sisters as a very dedicated trade unionist. He was always concerned about the integrity of the labor movement and encouraged participation among his members. . . . Brother Nylin is in many ways the epitome of the idea and practice of unionism." He will be sadly missed by all!!!

The Americans With Disabilities Act

The Americans with Disabilities Act ("ADA") went into effect on July 26, 1992. It provides equal rights to 43 million disabled people in the United States.

To be "qualified" under the ADA, a person must meet the job requirements such as training and certification and must be able to perform the essential functions of the job **with or without** reasonable accommodation.

The ADA prohibits discrimination against persons with disabilities. It also prohibits retaliation against anyone for opposing ADA violations or for cooperating in ADA enforcement. Under the ADA, employers and unions cannot coerce, intimidate or interfere with anyone's exercise of rights under the ADA.

Qualified disabled employees may take legal action to enforce their rights under the ADA. The ADA also authorizes the unions' involvement as the disabled employee's exclusive representative. Union members who may be protected by the ADA should notify their unions if they need any accommodation or feel they are being subjected to disability discrimination on the job.

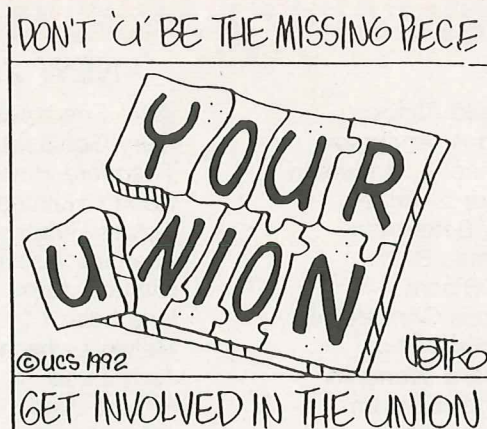
